More books will be added during the Regular sale.

The book sale is the Friends' biggest annual fundraiser. All proceeds go to benefit the Library directly.

Please have consideration for others, enjoy yourself and let everyone have a fair chance at finding the great bargains. All book sale customers are required to abide by the following rules of etiquette:

1. Grabbing shelves full of books is forbidden. Replace books you don't want on the shelf or table they came from.
2. Books must be collected in bags or boxes. **No piling of books covered or uncovered will be permitted in the sale room.**
3. Please promptly remove items you have paid for. Dealers/Bulk Buyers, please see Parrish about running a tab.
4. Scanners are allowed, but **please do NOT leave any books you want to buy unattended.** Books left in piles in the sale room will be collected for re-shelving.
5. Please do NOT haggle over prices. The prices are posted. Any Premium books have prices marked in pencil on the first page.
